Stem: What is the approximate distance and the direction you would need to travel?

- A. 600 miles northeast
- B. 600 miles southeast
- C. 1200 miles northeast
- D. 1200 miles southeast

Rationales:

- A. This is the approximately half the distance required and in the wrong direction.
- B. This is the correct direction, but only half the distance required.
- C. This is the correct distance, but in the wrong direction.
- D. Correct. The port of Alexandria, Egypt is approximately 1200 miles southeast of Rome.
