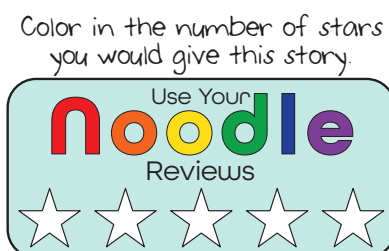

Parent Guide

Tips for Helping Your Child Read the Story

- **Preview Together:** Look at the title and the first few lines. Ask, “What do you think this story will be about?”
- **Read Aloud:** Take turns reading paragraphs or let your child read to you. Encourage using an excited voice, especially during the magical parts!
- **Pause to Visualize:** Ask your child to close their eyes and picture what’s happening after key moments (like seeing the glowing footprints).
- **Use a Highlighter:** Let your child highlight or underline important parts that help answer the questions.
- **Discuss Vocabulary:** Circle new or challenging words and discuss their meanings. This helps to expand your child’s vocabulary and understanding of the story.
- **Noodle Review:** Ask your child why they reviewed the story the way they did. What would earn the story more stars?
- **Celebrate Curiosity:** If your child asks “What if...?” or imagines other story ideas, encourage them to explore those thoughts.

Suggested Answers to Questions

What unusual thing did Emma find in the forest, and where did it lead her?

- She found glowing footprints that led her to a little door at the bottom of a tree.

Describe the features of the magical world Emma discovered. Circle or underline the parts of the story that detail these features.

- It was a place where animals could talk and flowers sang sweet songs.

Who did Emma meet in the hidden world, and what did they tell her?

- She met Ollie, the wise old owl, who explained that the footprints belonged to Flora, a kind deer who protected the forest.

Why do you think Flora, the deer, was important to the forest? What clues in the story tell you this?

- Flora protected the forest.

What do you think happened next? Draw a picture of what you think Emma and Flora’s next magical adventure might be. Where will they go, and who will they meet?

- Encourage your child to dream big! Maybe Emma and Flora discover a crystal cave, meet a dragon, or save a river from drying up.

At-Home Family Extensions

Nature Walk Adventure: Go on a walk and pretend you are following glowing footprints. What magical thing might be around you?

Create Your Own Secret World: As a family, invent a magical world together. Name it, decide who lives there, and describe what magical powers it has.

Story Expansion: Write a short sequel together. What challenge will Emma face next?
